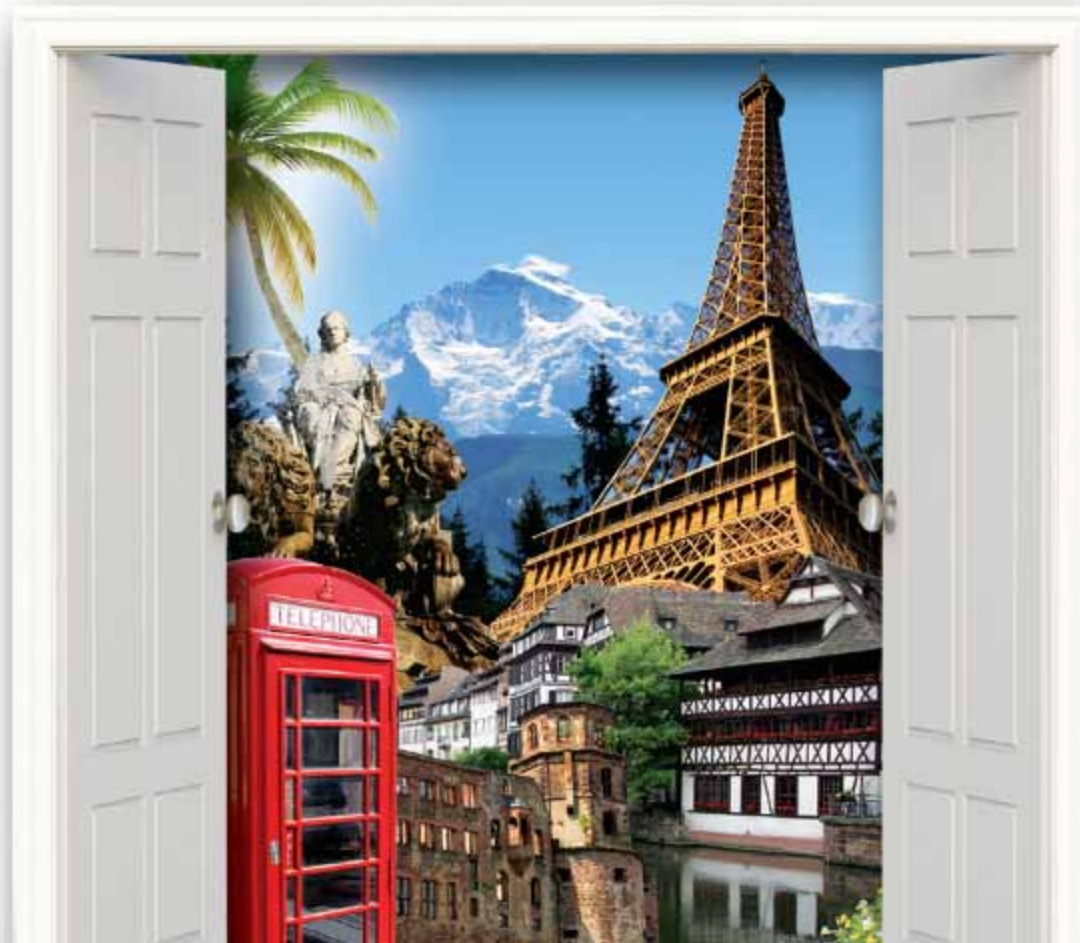

- In 1964, over 40 years ago, a man had a **vision** that people from all over the world should have a place where they could learn together.
- A place where **cultural diversity** would foster peace and understanding among nations.
- A place where **friendships** could develop that would bring nations closer together and **make the world a better place to live, work and play.**
- **Dr. Walter Leibrecht**, launched his first University in Kleiningersheim Castle, Germany, with this very mission in mind.
- He named the University after the famous German poet, historian, philosopher, and dramatist, **Friedrich von Schiller**, who embodied many of his ideals.

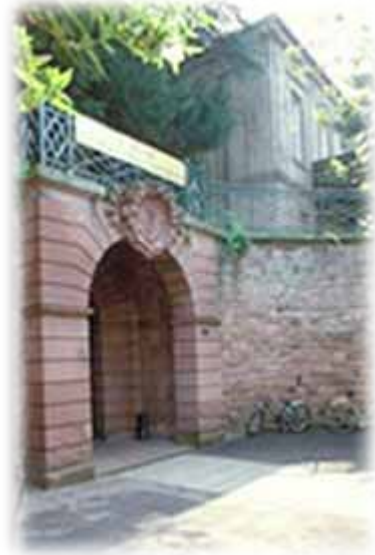
